### **Minutes of the Meeting – December 2011**

1. **Monthly Meeting:** The monthly Executive Board Meeting of the Military Marksmanship Association was held December 2, 2011 in the Army Marksmanship Unit Conference Room.

e. **Call to Order:** A quorum being present, the President called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

2. **Treasurer's Report:** Motion made, seconded, and carried to approve the October 2011 Treasurer's Report and the November 2011 Treasurer's Report.

3. **Minutes:** No meeting held in November. A memorandum stating that no meeting was held in November along with the November 2011 Treasurer's Report was forwarded to DFMWR.

4. **Unfinished Business:**

a. **Life Member and Member Pins Status:** The Treasurer said that all Life Member pins have been mailed. He added that the last batch of general membership pins was being processed.

b. **IRS Exempt Organization:** The Secretary reported that the number of War Veterans was below 90% for October and November. He noted that the MMA was still a tax exempt organization but was not able to accept tax deductible donations under the IRS code as a War Veterans Organization. He added that he has posted this information on the MMA web site.

5. **New Business:**

a. **Membership Status:** The Membership Chairman provided the following membership status:

- Gain/Loss (+/-) from previous month: -38
- New Life Members: Greg A. Strom, Service Rifle.
- Deceased: SFC Harley J. "Doc" Nolden, Service Pistol Shooter and Coach.

b. **Soldier of the Year Award:** The President announced that Smith & Wesson was behind in production and might not be able to provide the Soldier of the Year award by the presentation date. He noted that Smith & Wesson has issued a certificate for presentation.

c. **Soldier of the Year Vote:** The President asked Executive Board members to review the military biographies of nominees for MMA Soldier of the Year. He announced that the board would vote for soldier of the year on December 16<sup>th</sup> prior to the mail out of the MMA Times.

d. **MMA General Membership Meeting:** The President announced that the MMA Annual General Membership Meeting would be held at 2:00 PM on Friday, February 3, 2012 in the Pool Indoor Range.

e. **Request for MMA Times:** The Secretary stated that he had received an e-mail from the spouse of deceased member LTC Conway, requesting that she continue to receive the MMA Times. Without objection, the President then directed that her name be added to the MMA Times courtesy copy list.

f. **Request to Operate as a Private Organization:** The Secretary stated that he had submitted a request to DFMWR on November 21, 2011 to renew permission for the MMA to operate on Fort Benning as a Private Organization. He noted that the request would be routed through JAG and from past experience it would take that least 30 days to complete.

g. **MMA Times Input:** The Secretary reminded board members that input for the December issue of the MMA Times was due today and that the issue would be mailed on the 16th of December.

h. **USAMU Report:**

- **USAMU Ball:** The USAMU Deputy announced that the annual USAMU is scheduled for Saturday, January 28, 2012. He said that MMA board members would receive a formal invitation.

- **Olympic Quota Slots:** USAMU shooters earned additional Olympic quota slots at the XVI Pan American Games held in Guadalajara, Mexico. Thanks to USAMU shooters, the U. S. Olympic team now has the maximum two quota slots in each Olympic shooting event. Additional Olympic tryout matches will be held at Anniston, Alabama and at Fort Benning in early 2012. Paralympics trials will also be held on Fort Benning ranges.

- **Afghanistan Deployment:** The deployment to Afghanistan of a new USAMU Mobile Training Team and rotation of the existing team out of Afghanistan has been completed.

- **Change of Command:** The USAMU will conduct a Change of Command ceremony on June 13, 2012. The incoming commander is LTC Stephen King.

- **Sergeant Major Position:** The USAMU Sergeant Major position has been upgraded to Command Sergeant Major.


